



The MELVYL® System

The MELVYL® system is the centralized online catalog for the UC system. MELVYL® databases can be reached from terminals in libraries at all nine campuses of the University of California. The system can also be reached by any terminal or microcomputer with dialup access to UC computers connected to the MELVYL® system. Network access to the MELVYL® system is available to all users on the Internet.

The MELVYL® system includes a library catalog database, a periodicals database, article citation databases, and other files. All these databases are searched using the same basic commands.

The CATALOG and TEN-YEAR databases contain records for books, maps, music and other materials at the nine UC campuses and at California State Library locations in Sacramento and San Francisco. The PERIODICALS database contains records for periodical titles at UC and other academic libraries in California including Stanford, USC and the California State Universities.
