National Anthem: *United States Navy Band "Sea Chanters"*

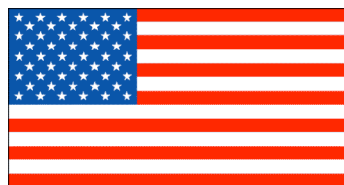
