To locate a journal, use a **Start of Journal Title** search on the Basic Search screen.

Why not search by the author or title of the article? -- **REMINDER** -- Author's names and titles of articles are not indexed in library catalogs; these are indexed in "article databases", such as SciFinder Scholar and PubMed

Search Note: Full titles of journals are usually needed when searching the UCLA Library Catalog

Help with finding journal titles from journal title abbreviations

Chemical Abstracts Service Source Index (CASSI) (SEL/Chem QD 1 A43 1907-99), or try "The next best thing to searching CASSI" <<http://www.cas.org/Support/DDS/ddsearch.html>>
Search Note: Search by keywords including journal abbreviation, ISSN or ISBN, and CODEN; omit periods (punctuation) from journal abbreviations.

Alternatively, to search abbreviated journal titles, replace periods (punctuation) with a question mark ? (truncation symbol), e.g. *Ark? Kemi* and use a **Keyword** search. To use truncation in the UCLA Library Catalog, a minimum of three letters are needed before using a question mark.
