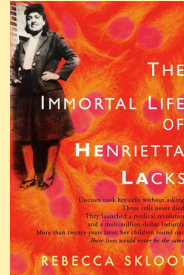


Read the Book Everyone is Reading!

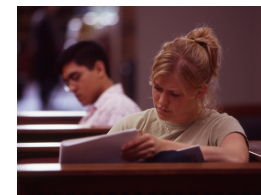
Want to generate your own anagram? Go to <http://www.wordsmith.org/anagram> and type in your name or a favorite phrase.
