



Find Useful Education, Literary Criticism, Sociology & Science Articles Using “CSA* Databases”

<p>What's In CSA?</p> <p>25 databases, including:</p>	<p>ERIC 1966-Current. Indexes education-related journal articles, reports, & more.</p> <p>GeoRef 1693-Current (North America coverage); 1933-Current (Worldwide coverage) 2.6 million references to geoscience journal articles, books, maps, conference papers, and more.</p> <p>MLA International Bibliography 1926-Current. International index to over 4400 periodicals & many books on literary criticism, language, folklore, & linguistics</p> <p>PsycInfo 1806-Current. Indexes 1800 journals, book chapters, & more, related to psychology.</p> <p>Sociological Abstracts 1952-Current. Indexes 1800+ periodicals, books, book chapters, dissertations & more on social structure, inequality, social change, social problems, etc.</p>
<p>Why Use CSA?</p>	<p>To find scholarly materials on many research topics (e.g. articles, book chapters, etc.).</p>
<p>Get Started</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Start at the UCLA Library home page: http://www2.library.ucla.edu/ Pull down the Search & Find menu, click Article Databases, type a database name (e.g. PsycINFO) & press enter.
<p>Search</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Type search words in the boxes & click Search. 
<p>Find More</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To increase your results, use fewer search words or use a truncation symbol. <i>Example: Film*</i> searches for all words that start with film, such as films and filming. <p><u>Still not enough?</u> Drop the quotations and put search words on different lines. Switch or add databases by clicking on Specific Databases.</p>
<p>Find Less</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To decrease your results, use more search words. <p><u>Still too many?</u> Set search limits at bottom of first search screen. <i>Example: Limit by date range, to journal articles, and/or to English only.</i> Switch or drop databases by clicking on Specific Databases. Use search limits (may differ from one database to another).</p>
<p>Evaluate Results</p>	<p>Sift through results to find the most useful items by answering these questions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Who wrote it? (Expertise) <input type="checkbox"/> Is it an article, book chapter, or dissertation? <input type="checkbox"/> When was it published? <input type="checkbox"/> Click on the title to read an abstract. (abstract=summary) <input type="checkbox"/> In which publication did it appear?
<p>Display Useful Results</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Pick a useful item. Click View Record to see more information about the item.
